



## **BCC Junior Monday Developmental Program – 2019 Overview**

The BCC Junior Monday Program is open and available for BCC Junior Members and Non-Members purchasing the below program options. Below are the 2018 Junior membership/program rates. Currently, we have about 60 juniors registered in the program. Our goal is to build this program to attract over 70 juniors in the near future. Our juniors represent our future golfers!

### **Full Junior Membership Options**

**Note:** BCC Adult Members can add a child or grandchild less than 19 years of age, include the first child at \$299 and all other children at no charge.

### **Monday Junior Program Only Rates:**

This program is designed for juniors interested in participating in the Monday Junior Program only. The below rates allow for participation in all 8 Monday Program dates. The juniors can golf as many holes as they desire on Monday's. Golfing any other day of the week would require paying the posted BCC Junior Green Fee Rates listed below.

The program aims to provide our Junior Members with quality instruction and learning opportunity designed not only teach our juniors the skills necessary to play and compete (if desired) but also the life skills gained from sport participation. Furthermore, we provide a social environment for our juniors to meet other juniors, make new friends and have fun!

### **Captain & Crew Day:**

Monday August 27<sup>th</sup>

On the final day of the junior Program on Monday August 27 we have set up a fun 9-hole scramble (Captain and crew) tournament and banquet. All juniors are encouraged to play in the fun scramble event. Golf tee times start at 9:00am for all juniors. We will mix up the kids into groups of various age and skill levels with coaches and parents playing also. Lunch and Prizes awarded after golf from 1-2pm

### **Weekly Agenda/Program Schedules**

Each week we run the following agenda and schedule. The older juniors are given the opportunity to play 18 holes (if desired) The Novice Boys and Girls will typically only play a few holes (Scramble) or the more advanced will often play 9 holes after the clinic.

#### **Junior Boys Group.**

- Arrive early between 7am-7:45 to warm up and prepare for clinic starting at 8am
- Play 9 or 18 holes, tee times off front nine at 9:00am
- Lunch (not included) optional after golf between 1:30pm - 2:30pm
- Ready for pick up/go home after 9 holes and lunch at 1pm or at 2:30pm if playing 18 holes.

#### **Novice Boys Group & Girls Group**

- Arrive between 8:30 and 8:50am, warm up practice putting green
- Lesson Clinic starts at 9am and ends at 10am
- Golf play tee times start on front nine at 10am, we break the kids into groups of 3 or 4
- Break for lunch after golf 12:30pm- 1:30pm
- Kids finished ready for pick up after lunch

### **Golf Genius Scoring:**

Again, this season we will be entering and tracking all the Junior scores (those that complete 18 or 9 holes) into the Golf Genius System. This will allow our coaches and players to track scores and coach our competitive juniors based on their scoring performance.

Reminder on Junior Golf Playing Privileges below...

### **Junior Golfer**

**Junior Golfer** has not reached the age of 19 years old as of April 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Junior Golfer Novice:** being of an age of 8 – 12 as of April 1 of the current year.

**Family Junior:** A junior attached by an adult member of the Club. (Parent or Grandparent)

**Independent Junior:** A junior not attached by an adult family member of the club.

**Junior Program Golfers:** A junior that is enrolled to participate in the BCC Monday Junior Program only. This allows them to participate in the Monday Instructional camp program including morning lessons and afternoon play opportunities. If they wish to play on other days they are required to pay the set junior public green fee rates.

### **Playing Privileges:**

\*Juniors may play golf on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays after 1:00pm (or between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm on weekends and holidays when playing with a regular member.) They may play after 1 pm on weekdays or between 8:00 am and 1:00pm if accompanied by an adult member.

The junior Golf Program runs Monday mornings during July and August. The Club requires children under the age of ten to be under direct supervision of an adult when on the golf course, practice areas or in the clubhouse.

**Junior “Competitive”:** Juniors that qualify will be listed as “Junior Competitive” status members. This will allow them the extra privilege of being able to golf after 11am on weekdays and weekends without adult members being with them. To qualify juniors would need to be assessed by DSO Doug Wark for proper skill development, maturity and etiquette.
