



Welcome to the 2018/2019 Season!

Spread the word to everyone you know who wants to try curling! We will be holding a **Registration Day on Sunday, September 23rd, from 11am to 1pm**

All Welcome: Come and enjoy some complimentary appetizers and meet your Curling Council and the League Conveners. This is a great time to register for the season and sign up for the Leagues you wish to play in.

Notice: This year registration will be followed immediately by a **Curling Town Hall Meeting, starting at 1:00 pm.**

BCC's Director of Sport Operations Doug Wark enters his second year and is excited about this year's program that will focus on launching the exciting new BCC Winter Slam 2-day Curling & Entertainment Event scheduled for November 16 & 17th, 2018. We will continue to host our popular TGIF Open Rink curling on most Fridays offering "Wing Nights" and entertainment. Doug will be working closely with Katherine Brown and Andrew Bischof to continue to expand and better the Junior Curling Program. Doug has also formed a Sales Committee to sell new rink sponsorships and Winter Slam advertising/sponsorships.

Doug will kick off the season with 3 Learn to Curl Open Houses where we welcome both returning players and new curlers to come out and refresh their skills, or simply learn for the first time. The Open Houses are scheduled for Wednesday through Friday, October 17, 18 & 19 from 1:00- 4:00pm and 6:00-8:00pm each day.

Also we offer a new schedule of regular free "Learn to Curl Clinics" every Friday from 12:00 - 1:00pm, followed by a new Friday afternoon "Senior Open Rink League" from 1:00-3:00pm. This is designed to provide an opportunity for seniors (and non-seniors) to come out and learn to curl and enjoy social time meeting new friends at the Club.

Expanding on the success of our TGIF Open House nights we will be launching the introduction of a new bi-weekly "Friday Fun Beer League" and a bi-weekly new pick-up "Doubles Curling League" (made popular by the Olympics). See posters outlining the details and schedules.

Matt Hone will continue as our Head Ice Technician. Matt has done a great job over the past few years and we expect more of the same! Matt will be joining forces with Sport Director Doug Wark to co-ordinate the many existing and exciting new BCC curling leagues and events this season. John Wall will again be installing our ice this year turning on the plant Wednesday Oct 3rd so we can optimize our hydro usage & resultant costs.

I would like to announce that Kathy Francis will be our new Convener for the Tuesday Day Ladies League, taking over from Lorna VanBridger. Thank you Lorna for serving as the Convener for a number of years !!! A job well done !

We would also like to welcome Steve Wilson as a new member of Curling Council this year. We have room for additional new committee members (especially younger members as they represent our future!) please contact Doug Wark if you are interested in serving.

Also, we have lost Stu Ferguson, a member of Council and The Board of Directors. Due to the closure of P & G plant he has accepted a job in the GTA starting the end of August. Stu will be missed for sure. Thank you for all your time and involvement on the Curling side Stu.

We are still trying to improve Hydro usage. We did save a reasonable amount by going into Set Back Mode last year and feel it was worth it. We are going to do this again this year once the weather gets cold outside and remains cold.

This year with our ice installation commencing October 2nd or 3rd, we expect the ice to be ready for the Open House Clinics Oct 17-19 and the Leagues will be starting on Sunday, October 21st. We will keep you posted as to our early season Curling Clinics. Also, the Annual Swing & Sweep will be held, Saturday, October 20th, to kick off the Curling Season.

Another important date to keep in mind is the **Winter Slam which will be held, Friday, November 16th and Saturday, November 17th. Keep your calendar open and watch for updates.** Like the Summer Slam which was a fund raiser for the Golf Section this will be a fund raiser for the Curling Section.

As for Curling itself we must be more focused on how long it takes to play an 8-end game. It should take no longer than 2 1/4 hours Max. We will be reminding everyone about this throughout the Season.

Additional New Member Information:

- * An annual Curling Capital Fund assessment of \$60.00 + HST will be charged to all BCC Curling Members at the beginning of the season.
- * As a minimum, all fees are to be paid before the commencement of each draw. If you plan to curl in all draws in any given league, you are strongly encouraged to pay all fees in full prior to season commencement.

Curling Payment Plan for Current Members:

A payment plan of 4 installments is available for a service fee of \$20.00+HST.

Members are expected to pay \$175.00 + HST by Friday October 12th.

The balance of their membership, the curling capital fund and the service fee will be invoiced in 3 equal invoices at the end of October, November and December.

Members on the payment plan must have a current member account.

First year/new member curlers, once a week nonmembers, student and junior members are not eligible for the payment plan.
