## **2020 Junior Golf Program:**

The 2020 program is being led by PGA Director of Sport Operations – Doug Wark, with assistance from BCC PGA Golf Instructor David Inch, Proshop Manager A.J. Howe and a team of member/parent volunteers. The program has a long history of success at the BCC, not only in developing highly skilled players but also teaching and coaching our kids to be outstanding individuals with proper golf etiquette, fair sportsmanship and positive attitudes. The instruction focuses on teaching proper golf fundamentals and technique on full swing, driving, wedges, chipping, pitching and putting. Each day the juniors are given the opportunity to play on the course after their lesson. In addition, the kids enjoy meeting new friends and spending time socializing and other non-golf activities. ### **Junior Golfer**

**Junior Golfer** has not reached the age of 19 years old as of April 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Junior Golfer Novice:** Being of an age of 8 – 12 as of April 1 of the current year.

**Family Junior:** A junior attached to an adult member of the Club.

**Independent Junior:** A junior not attached by an adult family member of the club.

**Junior Program Golfers:** A junior that is enrolled to participate in the BCC Monday Junior Program only. This allows them to participate in the Monday Instructional camp program, including morning lessons and afternoon play opportunities. If they wish to play on other days, they are required to pay the set junior public green fee rates that apply when playing Tuesday – Sunday.

**Junior Playing Privileges:** Juniors may play on weekends and holidays after 1:00 PM, or between 11:00 AM and 1:00 PM if playing with a golf adult member. They may play after 8:00 AM on weekdays.

**Junior “Competitive”:** Juniors that qualify will be listed as “Junior Competitive” status members. This will allow them the extra privilege of being able to golf weekends and holidays after 11 am on weekends without adult members being with them. To qualify juniors would need to be assessed by DSO Doug Wark (or delegate) for proper skill development, maturity and etiquette. \*NOTE: DSO Doug Wark can revoke this privilege at any time.
